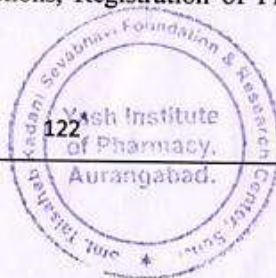



#### 1. Brief proceedings of the event:

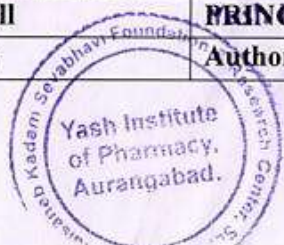

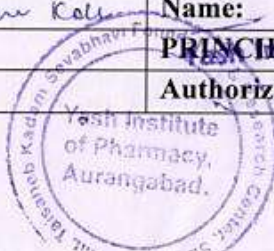
On Day 4<sup>th</sup> (18/2/21)

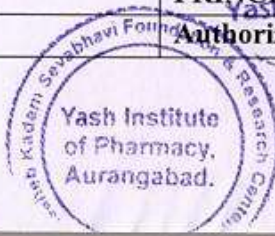

The program ended with the vote of thanks proposed by Gayatri, Rushikesh and Nischay, student of first year B. Pharm.

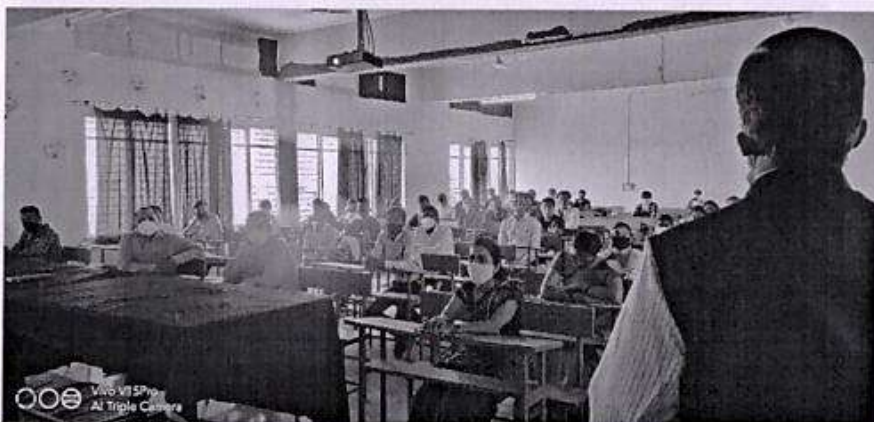
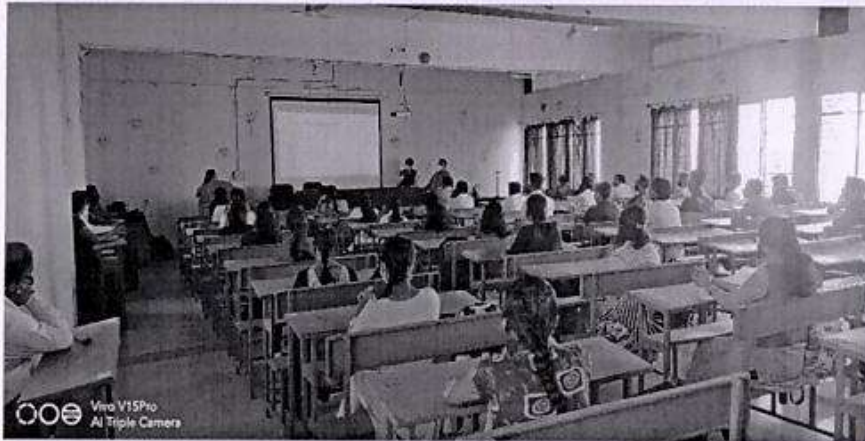


**2. Brief description of the activity conducted:**
