Feedback on curriculum

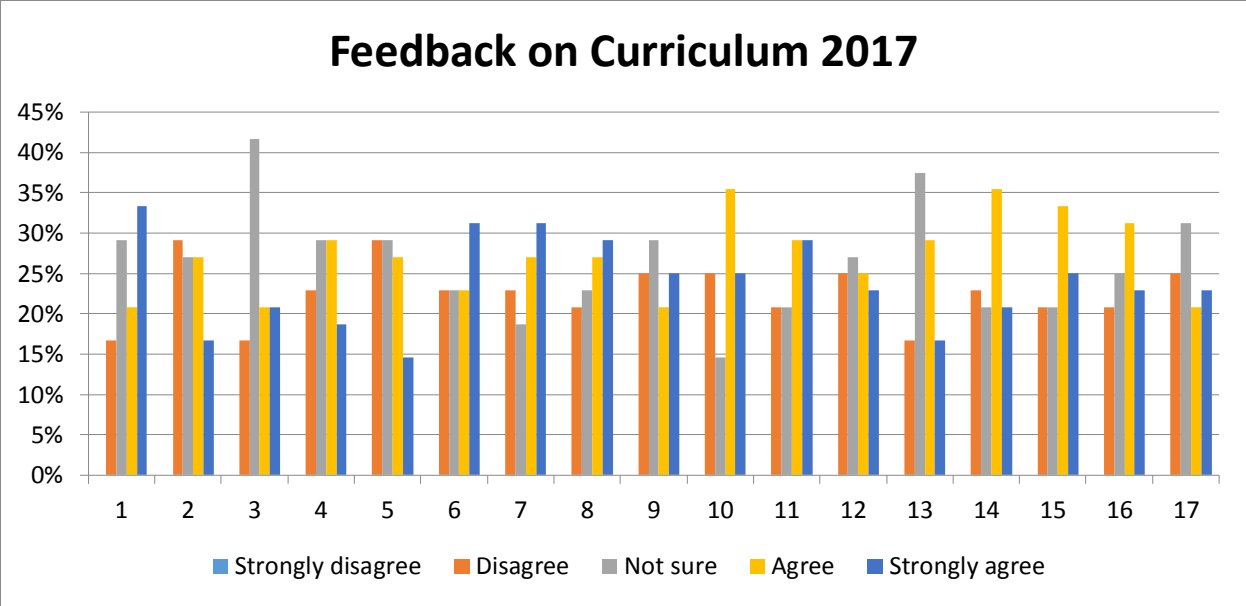
Questionnaire for Feedback on curriculum:
