
2. Brief description of the activity conducted:

Day 1 (11/9/2023)


Session I: Inaugural Function

Anti Ragging cell



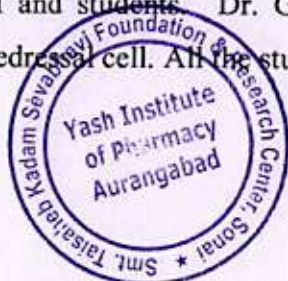
Vishaka cell



Mentoring cell



Session II:


