

Report on Student's Satisfaction Survey


For the NAAC AQAR 2023-24, a Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) was conducted through a Google form to gather feedback from students. The questionnaire, structured as per NAAC guidelines and used Likert type scale ranging from 0 to 5, with 5 indicating the most positive response and 0 the lowest. The question-wise outcome of the results is presented below:


1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class? 99 responses



2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes? 99 responses




3. How well were the teachers able to communicate domain Knowledge ? $_{\rm 99\,responses}$




4. How is the teacher's approach to teaching?




5. Do the teacher discuss your performance in assignments with you?



6. How much the teachers are Fair in the internal evaluation process ? $_{\rm 99\,responses}$




7. Do the teachers illustrate the concepts through illustrations, examples and applications? 99 responses




8. Do the institute take active interest in essential activities suchas promoting internship, student exchange, industrial / field visit opportunities for students?




9. Does your mentor do follow up of the task assigned to you? 99 responses




10. The institution provides multiple opportunities to students forlearning and growth including seminar, group discussions, case based learning.


11. Do the teachers inform you about your expected curriculum competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes ?


12. To what extent the mentoring process in the institute is beneficial to you for social, emotion and cognitive growth?




13. Do the teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges ?




14.Do the teachers able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them ? $_{99\,\mathrm{responses}}$




15. Do the institution makes effort to monitor and evaluate for assessing the effectiveness and interactiveness of the classroom / learning process?


16 .The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.




17. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching?



18.To what extent practical facilities related to your disciplinehave been made available to you? 99 responses




19. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities and overall development. 99 responses




20. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the society
