The activity contributed to raising awareness among school students regarding essential healthcare practices, empowering them to adopt healthier lifestyles and make informed decisions about their well-being. Pharmacy students honed their communication and interpersonal skills through their interactions with school students, effectively conveying complex health-related information in an accessible manner.
