
2. Brief description of the activity conducted:




3. Impact of the activity (Outcomes for students and/or staff):


2. Brief description of the activity conducted:

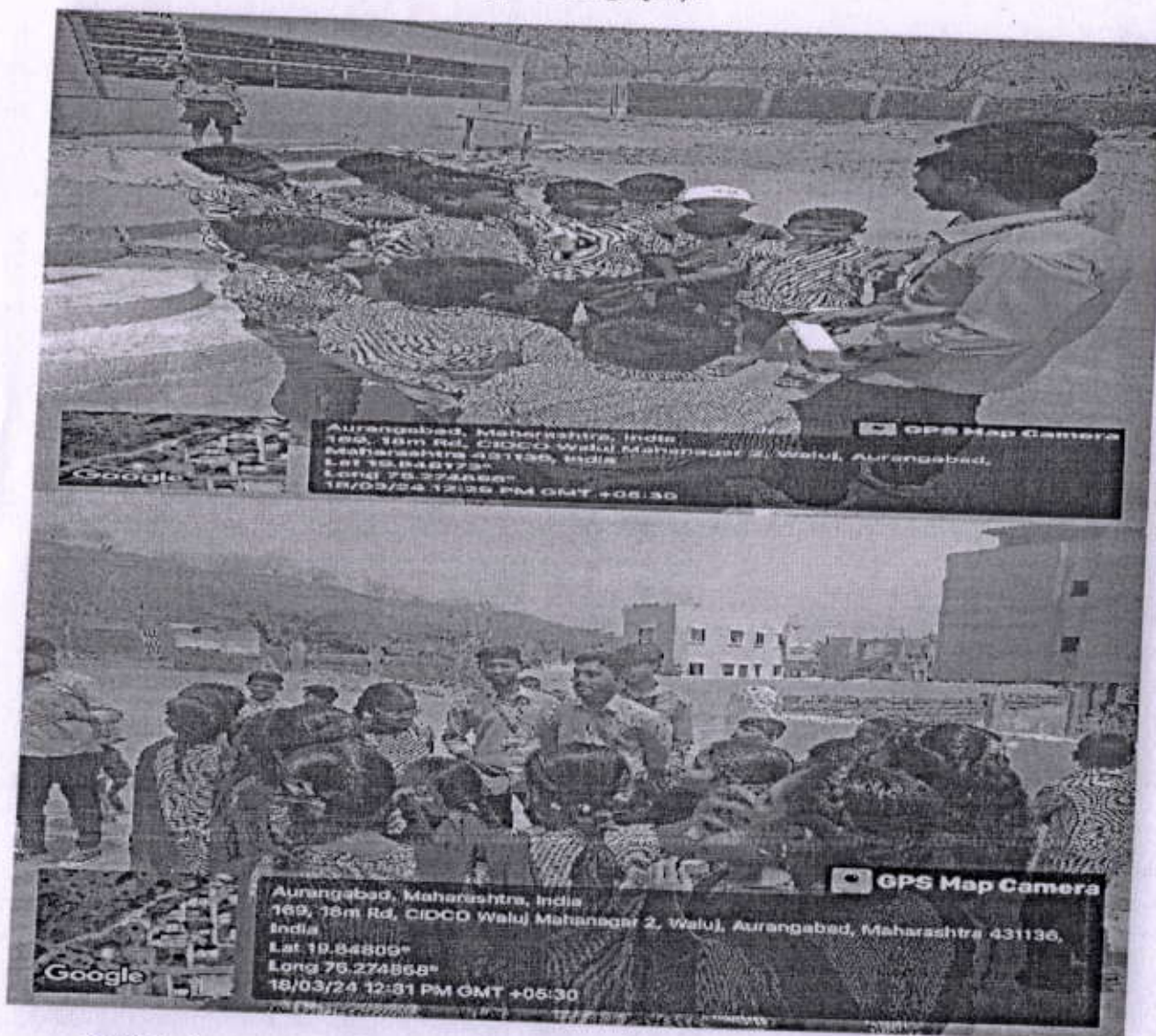
