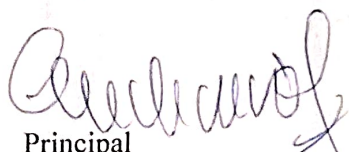

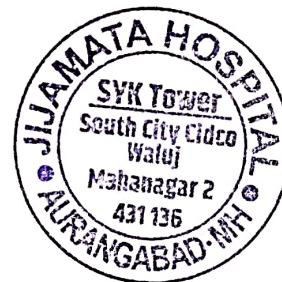

2. Brief description of the activity conducted:

On the fourth day of the NSS Special Camp organized by Yash Institute of Pharmacy, an Eye and Ear Checkup Camp was conducted at Z.P. School, Golwadi, in collaboration with Jijamata Hospital. The primary objective of the camp was to provide healthcare support to school children and spread awareness about the importance of eye and ear health.

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A total of **118 children** from **Z.P. School, Golwadi** participated in the health camp. The medical team conducted comprehensive screenings for various **eye and ear-related conditions**. The tests included:

- ✓ Vision tests to detect refractive errors.
- ✓ Screening for common eye infections and other visual impairments.
- ✓ Awareness on eye care and hygiene.
- ✓ Hearing tests to identify potential hearing impairments.
- ✓ Examination for ear infections, blockages, or other ear-related concerns.
- ✓ Guidance on proper ear hygiene and preventive care.

• **Early Detection of Health Issues:** Many children were diagnosed with minor eye and ear problems, allowing for timely medical intervention.

• **Increased Health Awareness:** Students were educated about the importance of regular checkups and maintaining good hygiene.

The introduction of the program was given by **Third-Year student Janvi Devtaival**, who warmly welcomed all guests, medical professionals, faculty members, and students. She highlighted the importance of healthcare initiatives and the role of NSS in community service.

3. Impact of the activity (Outcomes for students and/or staff):

The **Eye and Ear Checkup Camp** conducted at **Z.P. School, Golwadi** as part of the **NSS Special Camp** had a significant impact on both students and staff. The initiative successfully promoted **preventive healthcare**, increased awareness about **eye and ear health**, and provided a meaningful learning experience for **NSS volunteers**.

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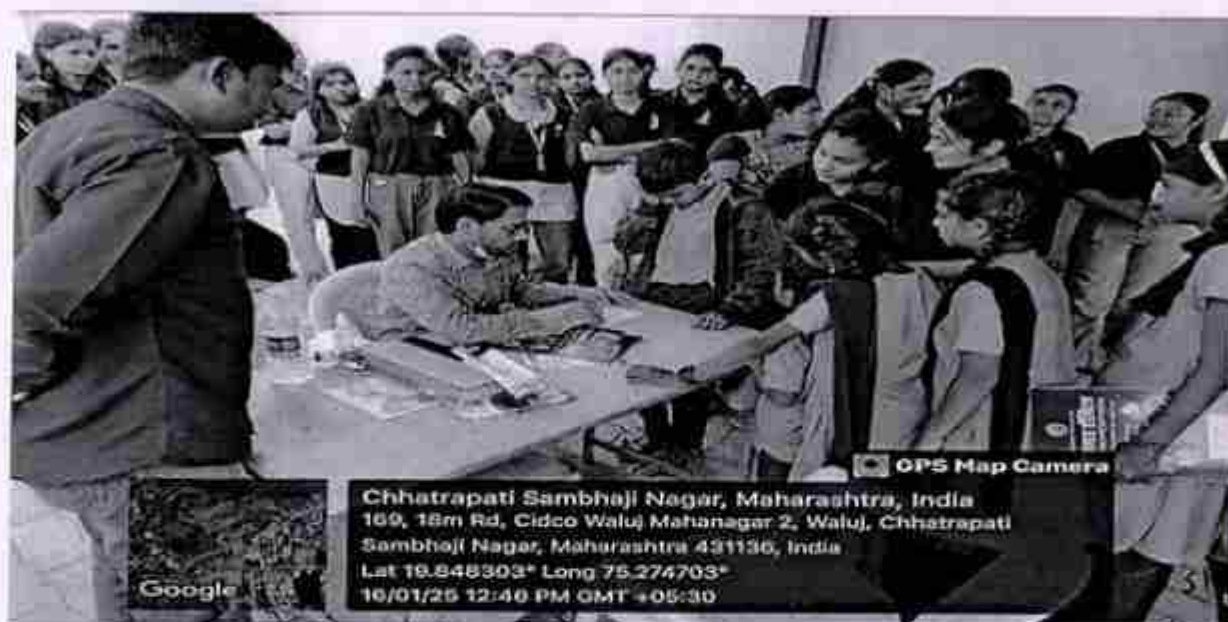

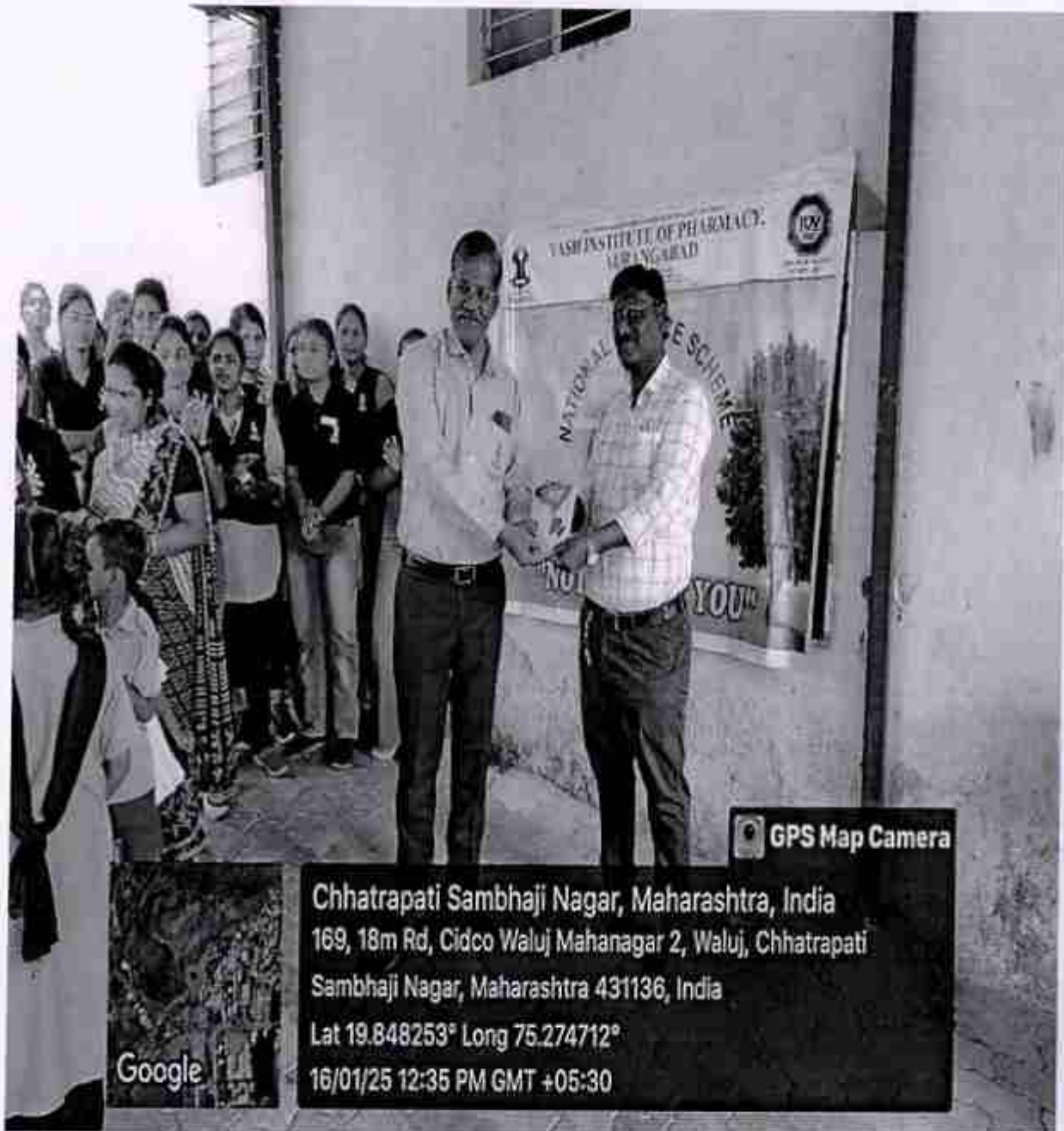
