The institution became a constituent unit of KLE Academy of Higher Education and Research (KAHER), Belagavi, [Deemed-to-be University] in 2009. is one of the premier educational group imparting high quality health profession's education at Under-Graduate, Post-Graduate and Post-doctoral levels in Pharmacy, Medicine, Dental, Ayurveda, Basic science, etc. KAHER Apart from this, the University has two Basic Health Science Research Centres, Central Research Facility in Ayurveda College and APJ Abdul Kalam Ayurtech Department in Ayurveda College, Drug Testing Laboratory, etc. KLE College of Pharmacy, Belagavi has transformed into a center of academic excellence and has been recognized as a Quality Improvement Program (QIP) by AICTE, New Delhi. It is also actively involved in various collaborative efforts ranging from organizing seminars, workshops, conferences etc.

Whereas the above named Institutions recognize that academic collaboration would be of mutual benefit and would strengthen mutual interest; thus it is agreed upon:

1. Each Institution shall promote the exchange of faculty for teaching, seminar, conference, and workshop and/or for collaborative research programs in the area of Pharmacy and overall health courses.
2. Each Institution shall provide access to instrumental facilities/machinery to students undertaking guided project with mutual consent.
3. Each Institution shall encourage student/s to take internship program/activities for mutually agreed period/s. Students shall not be liable to pay tuition fees that are involved at host institution in an internship program as it does not involve enrolling in classes. Respective faculty coordinators of host institutions shall look into applications for internship programs.
4. Students shall arrange for their own transportation, lodging, food etc. while attending such internship programs, seminar, conference, workshop etc.
5. In the event of any host Institutions receiving any grants/aids for conduct of seminar/conference/workshop/internship program/training program/faculty development program, host institution shall maintain all records pertaining to aid, disbursement, and record keeping.
6. Faculty exchange program/Intellect sharing may be done either in online or offline mode. Each Institution shall conduct such program/events with mutual consent and at such date and time consented by respective head of Institution.
7. This memorandum of agreement shall become effective on the final date of signing and shall have duration of five years.
8. Termination of this memorandum of agreement by either Institution with written notice of the head of Institution with at least six months duration.
9. Each Institution designates respective officials to serve as coordinators under this Memorandum of Agreement. Coordinators can be revised as and when the need arises with written information being provided to other Institution.

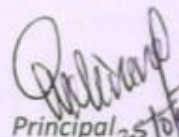

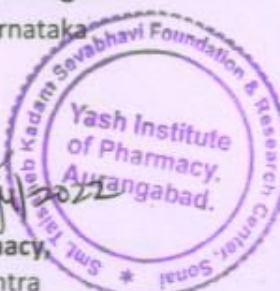
